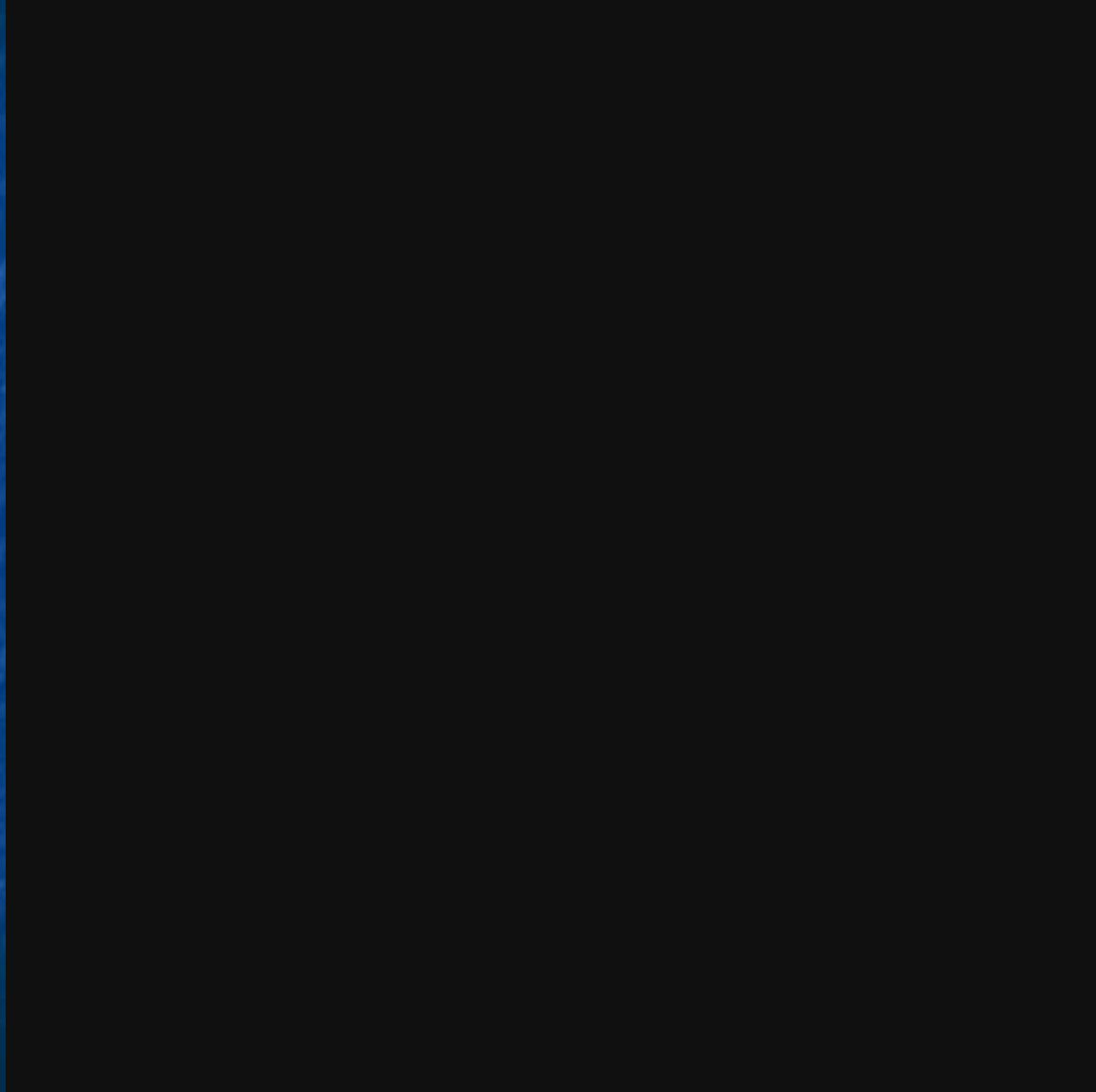

Herman B. Gentry's Head Injuries And Symptoms

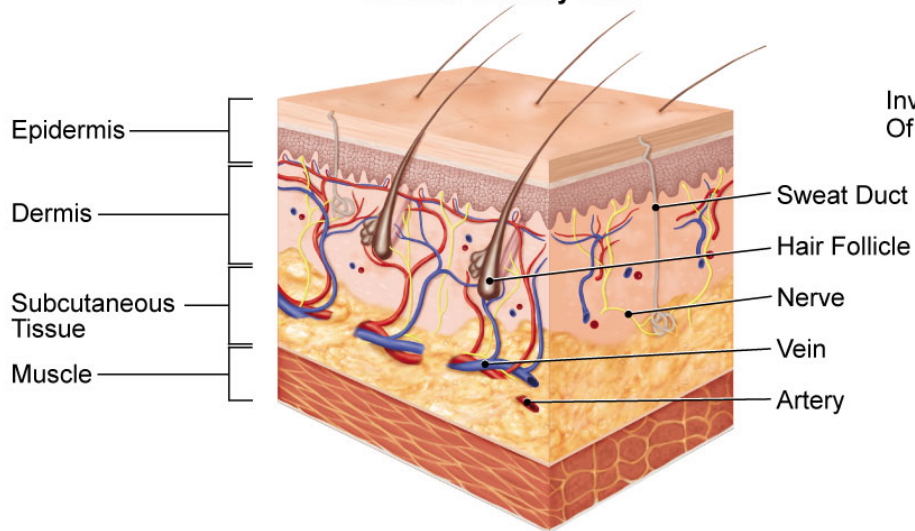


Herman B. Gentry's Hand Injuries

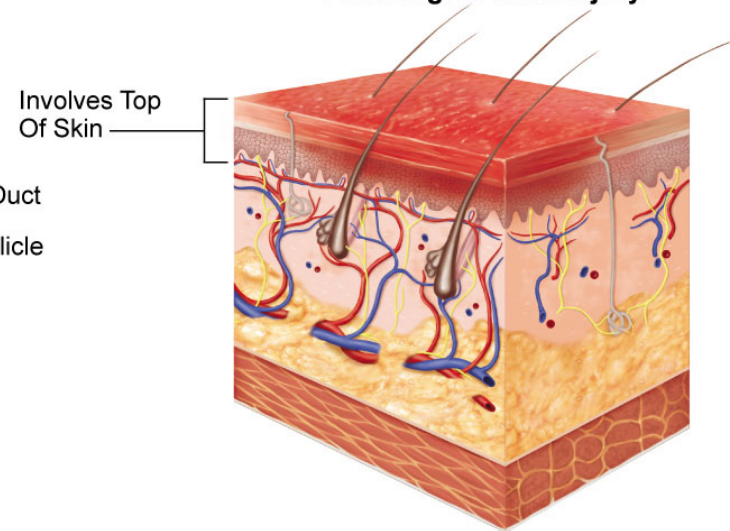


Varying Degrees Of Burn Injuries

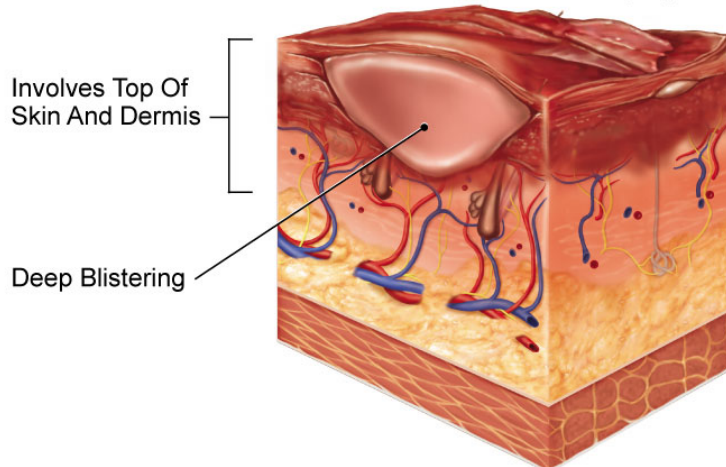
Normal Healthy Skin



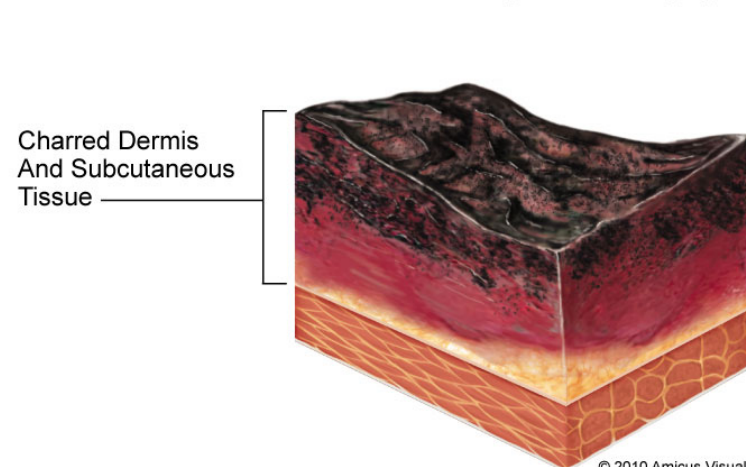
First Degree Burn Injury

Third Degree Burn Injury

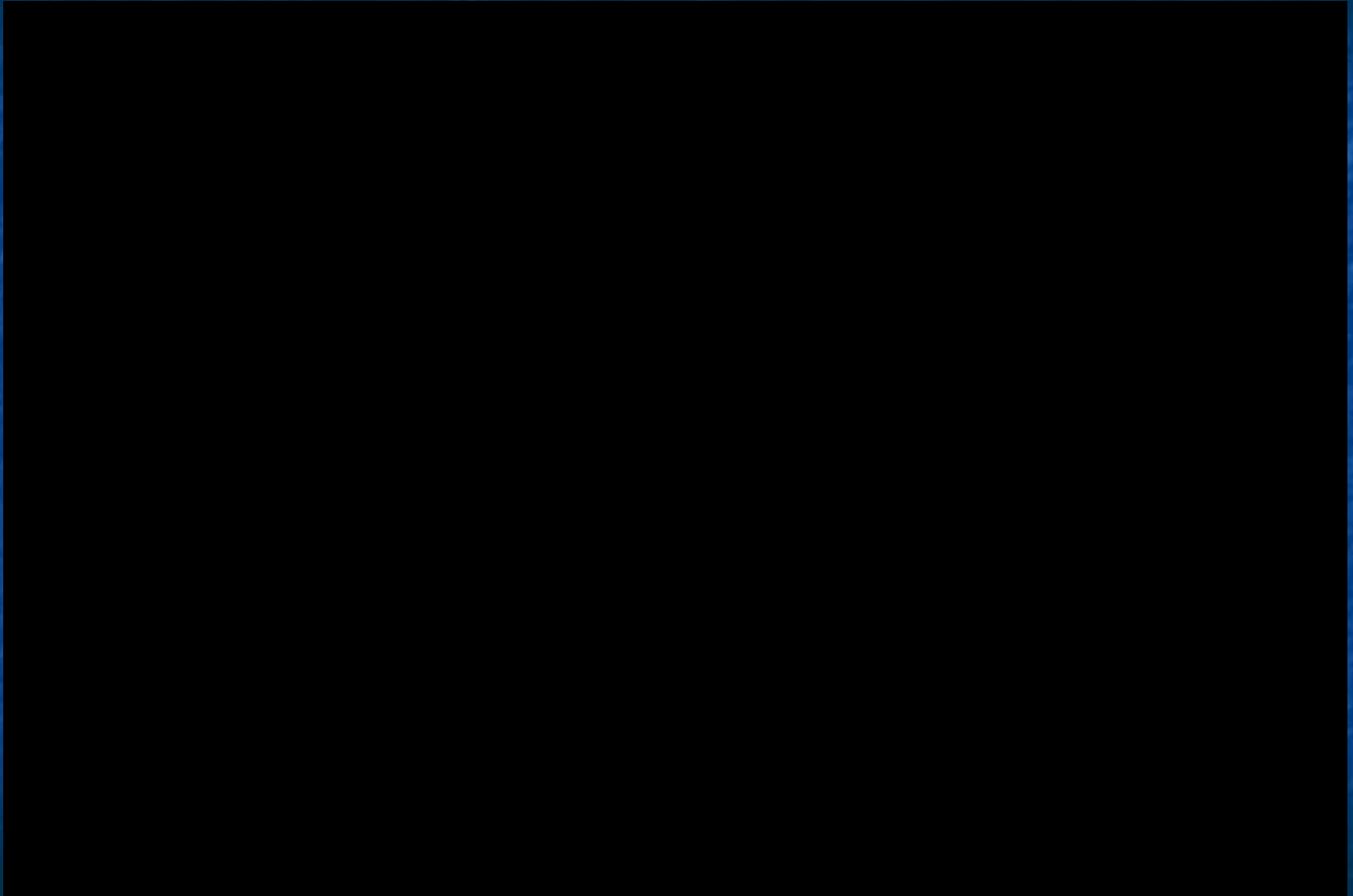

12 Medical Diagnosis

Burns involving the face, lower extremities, and right hand, approximately 40% total body surface area, with full-thickness burns noted on the lower extremities

Inhalation burns requiring intubation in the emergency department

40% total body surface burns

Inhalation injury with facial burns

Circumferential extremity burns

Interspinous ligament strain, C1-C2

Multiple infections in blood, wounds, and sputum

Chronic ventilator dependence

Functional dysphagia

Acute cholecystitis

Gangrenous cholecystitis

Burns to bilateral upper and lower extremities
